Teacher-to-Parents

Week-At-A-Glance

Literacy: We will read two books recently, The Lion and the Bird and Pierre the Penguin and we will read Maggie the One-Eyed Peregrine Falcon. We have been learning how to compare and contrast what happens to characters in different texts (some fiction, some non-fiction). Your child will be writing to compare and contrast on Friday. In Skills block we will be learning about vowel teams (ie. team, paint, boat).

Math: We are learning about money (penny, nickel, dime, quarter). We are learning how to show different money amounts using a variety of coins. We will learn now to show money amounts most efficiently (with the least amounts of coins). This is great to practice at home as well.

Social Studies: We are learning about the basics of economics including needs vs. wants, supply and demand, scarcity and limited resources, goods vs. services during morning meeting. Parents, use this to talk about what your child really needs and what is actually a want. Next week, students will begin to earn "money" for the jobs they do at school as well as learn about supply and demand in real ways. For example, how much will it cost for a pencil with an eraser? Very scarce in our classroom!
