Week-At-A-Glance

Literacy: We will begin module 4 unit 4 this week. This unit focuses on caring for birds and asks students to answer the question "Why should we care about birds?". We will begin by doing a text dive into 2 texts, "The Lion and the Bird" and "Pierre the Penguin" and starting class notes. In skills, students will continue to work with the "bossy "r"". We will learn how r-controlled vowels can change a vowel sound, focusing this week specifically on -or, -ir, and -ur.

Math: This week we will be wrapping up our work with 2D and 3D shapes. Students will focus on building composite shapes for both 2D and 3D shapes and take one final assessment for this concept. We will then move into our exploration of partitioning shapes, specifically circles and rectangles, into halves and fourths.

Science: We will be finishing our work with soil and plants. Students will be finishing a plant growth experiment with our class plant to see how removing a plants root impacts its ability to grow. They will use the scientific method to experiment and log their observations.
