
Today you are receiving your child's interim report. This lets you know how he/she is doing about halfway through the quarter. Please remember that your child will be getting more grades before the end of the quarter and that some grades may have been generated from 1 assessment. The report card has a more complete picture of how your child is doing. It is good to look at where some 1s and 2s are to see what might be happening. For example, we are expecting more of first graders with writing, so this grade may be low. I can't tell you how important it is for your child to write on their own at home. Not copying sentences, but writing something they want to say. This requires them to use what they have learned about letters and words in a meaningful way. They more they do it, the easier it gets.

Make sure you read about Dr. Seuss's birthday and Read Across America. I hope that we can have some guest readers.


