**Literacy:** We will be finishing our Did You Know booklets about the bird we chose to research. On Thursday we will do a science talk with 2 other students so we can share what we learned about our bird. In Skills, we will continue to practice reading and spelling CVCe words with the vowel letters e and u. We will learn about the few words that have "e" for the vowel. They will also use that some CVCe words with "u" sound like a long u and also /oo/.

**Math:** We will be practicing solving word problems this week. We will decide which equation matches which word problem. Students will also show their thinking in multiple ways. Solving word problems are a big part of the end of the year math assessment. We will continue to work with word problems and showing their thinking.

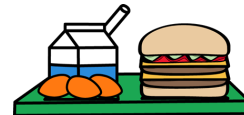
