Teacher-to-Parents

Dear Parents,

What a wonderful way to start our week with warm weather (I love warm weather!). As is usual for March in NC, we have a rollercoaster of weather ahead. Week-At-A-Glance

Literacy: We will be starting to write about a specific bird and will write about this birds in a Did You Know booklet. The students will write about how the bird's body parts help the bird survive. In Skills, we will continue to practice reading and spelling CVCe words with the vowel letters o and i. Please be sure to practice this at home. Ask your child about laser silent e. **Math:** We will be learning about how to find the number that is 10 more or 10 less than a number. We will start off showing our thinking with ten sticks and using tools such as a 100 board. We will move to having the students do this mentally (in their head). They will need to have a strong understanding of the digits value and the concept of more and less. This may also be described as, the number that comes "10 numbers before" or "10 numbers after a number".

Growth Mindset: This week we will focus on this fixed and growth mindset Fixed Mindset: **This is too hard.** vs Growth Mindset: **This may take some time and effort.**


