Week-At-A-Glance

Literacy: We will be writing a shared opinion writing to prepare for students writing their own opinion piece. Students will learn the parts of an opinion paragraph which includes: introduction, opinion statement, reason, conclusion. In skills block we will be learning about a different long vowel e vowel team (ee). We will also learn about the ending y that sounds like long vowel e and the sound /oo/ like in "room". Please be sure to practice this with your child. Here's how we mark them to read.

Math: We are reviewing what we have learned and beginning to take the summative assessment. We will be reviewing equations quite a bit. Here are some examples of what students will have to do:
