Week-At-A-Glance

Literacy: The students will be writing their own opinion writing for and assessment. They are doing much better, but some students continue to write quickly and not sound out words, use word patterns we have learned, and spelling resources in the classroom. In skills block we will be learning about a different long vowel i vowel team (ie). We will also learn about "igh" that also makes the long vowel I sound.

Math: The students will be doing a lot of work with equations this week and determining whether an equation or solution is true or not. The students will have to show their thinking by doing a circle drawing, counting on, or using a number line. We are practicing this to be sure they show their best.

ABC Countdown: We continue our ABC countdown with fun things but also special words from the book: A New Alphabet for Humanity Children's Book: A Children's Book of Alphabet Words to Inspire Compassion, Kindness and Positivity.
