Teacher-to-Parents

Dear Parents,

We got a lot of work done last week! The students have been using Habit 3 and are putting first things first. They worked on identifying the feelings characters had by using illustrations and the text. Some of the words for feelings were new for students, but we were able to find them. You can do this at home too! As you read a book with your child ask him/her, "How do you think ______ is feeling? What evidence do you have?" (Yes, they know what evidence is—though they may still have a hard time applying the concept). They can use illustrations they see or they can tell you about what the words say. Either of these is evidence. They also worked with word problems last week and they did a great job using the Part-Part-Whole model and the Start-Change-Result chart to organize their thinking. Ask your child about this. We have only worked with addition word problem so far, but they have done well.

We have finished learning about handwriting, but that doesn't mean that they are doing perfect handwriting. That is something that you and I will have to encourage and expect. You will find a handwriting chart attached. When your child writes at home make sure they are doing their best handwriting with the correct letter shape and the correct letter size. Let me know if you need paper to practice at home. I will be happy to send some home with your child.

Week-At-A-Glance

Literacy:

We will finish up the story "The Little Red Pen". They have really enjoyed this book. They will have to tell how a character is feeling on their own, then write about the habit of character that the character uses. Students are still learning about what it means to write. We will get there. We are starting to work on letter sounds and words in what we call a Skills Cycle. This is a 5 day cycle of work to learn a letter pattern and high frequency words. I will share more about this during conferences. We will be starting writing journals this week.

Math: We will take a break from word problems and learn how to use the Make A Ten strategy to solve addition equations. This is a great strategy but it may be new to you. Ask your child about it. They should be good at it by Friday.
